Dear Mr. O'Donnell:

On September 8, 2011, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) approved a"Draft Immediate Response Action Plan" for the Construction and Demolition Area (the "C&D Area") at the former Medfield State Hospital to excavate contaminated soil and debris, emplace a temporary sediment cap within the adjacent Charles River, and reconstruct the river bank to eliminate continued leaching and/or erosion of soil resulting in petroleum contamination of sediment that has is or likely to result in impacts to surface water as a condition of Substantial Release Migration. Approval and performance of the Immediate Response Action ("IRA") Plan was contingent upon several conditions and deadlines. On October 6, 2011, MassDEP received a "Request for Extension of Time" from the Division of Capital Asset Management ("DCAM"). Due to currently pending permitting appeals and planned withdrawal by DCAM of its federal Section 404 Permit Application, DCAM will be unable to meet the deadlines of the IRA Conditional Approval, and has requested an "indefinite" extension of the deadlines.

MassDEP has reviewed and considered DCAM's request to extend the Immediate Response Action deadlines indefinitely, and <u>denies</u> the requested extension. To amend the deadlines and/or scope of the IRA, MassDEP is requiring submittal of an IRA Plan Modification by **November 21, 2011**. In lieu of installing the temporary sediment cap and reconstruction and armoring of the riverbank at this time, the IRA Plan Modification should be limited to addressing sediment contamination within the Charles River including a monitoring program for sediment to ensure that sediment contamination remain stable and delineated, pending implementation of the Phase IV remedial action. Since it appears that emplacement of the temporary sediment cap will not be conducted and sediment dredging will ultimately be performed as part of the comprehensive remedial action, pending approval from the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACOE) and other permitting agencies, the IRA Plan Modification must include initiation of the USACOE permitting process. As the IRA Plan Modification will be limited to addressing sediment contamination,

riverbank reconstruction and armoring should be performed as a comprehensive response action in accordance with the Phase III Response Action Plan and Phase IV Remedial Investigation Plan. The first IRA Status Report shall be submitted by **February 21, 2011**, and quarterly thereafter to apprise MassDEP and stakeholders of any monitoring results and permitting progress.

On September 22, 2011, MassDEP received a "Draft Phase III – SPD Area and Power Plant Area Remedial Evaluation", subject to public comment as a Public Involvement Plan site. By **December 21, 2011**, please submit a schedule of deadlines for submittal of the Final Phase III Remedial Action Plan that incorporates responses to public comments and a schedule to implement the comprehensive response action during the 2012 construction season. An evaluation of the bioengineered riverbank armoring shall be included in the Phase III.
